

Camp Kulin Summer Update

2019 SUMMER SEASON

Camp Kulin completed our busiest summer season yet over December/ January. We ran seven five day sessions for 221 campers from 88 towns across WA (including 12 Kulin campers). 72 volunteers donated over 9000 hours of their time (equivalent of \$225,000 of time). including our first two Kulin campers from 2014, Jack August and Alexis Corlett, who are both now old enough to come back as volunteers. We ran over 20,000 minutes of activities, prepared over 6000 meals, travelled over 4000km to and from Perth for pickup/dropoff and raised over \$50,000 in child sponsorship. Feedback has been extremely positive from everyone involved. Thanks to Dot at the Kulin Aquatic Centre for being so awesome with our kids over the summer and to everyone who helped out with dropping in food, cooking and driving the buses for excursion days, we really appreciate your support!



2019 SCHOOL CAMPS

Term 1 is always the busiest term for school camps, with many regional schools now moving their student council training to Camp Kulin. We started the term with Narrogin Residential College and Cunderdin DHS in, and in the next few weeks we will also be running programs for Wagin DHS, Wongan Hills DHS, Dalwallinu DHS, Bruce Rock DHS, Kellerberrin DHS, Mukinbudin DHS, Nungarin PS, Merredin College, Moorine Rock PS, Dowerin DHS, Southern Cross DHS, St Matthews School Narrogin, East Narrogin PS and the Merredin CRC Community Camp.

WESTPAC SOCIAL CHANGE FELLOWSHIP

Tanya was announced this month as one of Westpac's Social Change Fellows for 2019. 



OVERDUE DOG AND CAT REGISTRATIONS

The Shire of Kulin advises that licences under the Dog Act 1996 and Cat Act 2011 are overdue for renewal as of the 31 October 2018. Residents who own a cat or dog are required by law to register the animal.

Also, under the current provisions of the Dog Act 1976;

- · All dogs must be microchipped once they are three months of age; and
- All dogs, irrespective of age must be microchipped prior to being sold or transferred to a new owner.

If your dog or cat is currently not registered please contact the office to arrange a licence, please note the Shire's Ranger has commenced issuing Warning Notices. Alternatively if you do not wish to renew the licence because the animal is no longer in your possession, please let us know.
