Council Decisions Dec 2018

DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY - 8 Wright St Kulin - having received no submissions relating to the disposition of property Council accepted an offer for the purchase of 8 Wright Street Kulin.

DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY – Transportable Offices – following the 'Sale by Tender' advertising period one tender was received which was accepted by Council.

WAR MEMORIAL – expenditure was authorised to purchase and erect an additional flag pole at the VDZ War Memorial.

EASTERN WHEATBELT BIOSECURITY GROUP – a letter of support will be sent to the Minister for Agriculture and Food providing support to the EWBG and requesting consideration to provide ongoing funding through Royalties for Regions.

DISPOSAL OF 'OLD' SHIRE OFFICE – Council agreed to investigate the possible rezoning of the old shire offices in consideration of selling this building in the future.

COMMUNITY BUS – quotes are being sought for a new community bus and Council will approach community groups to request financial assistance towards a new bus.

STAFF HOUSING – tenders to be called for a 3 x 2 staff house to be built on Robertson Estate.

SKELETON WEED – a marketing campaign is required to reinforce to farmers that skeleton weed is not a stigma and needs to be reported.



The mains connection to this standpipe is only a temporary short term fix until the tank on the hill has sufficient amount of rain water.

BUSHFIRE BRIGADE UPDATE

Bush Fires Act 1945 - Notice to all Owners and/or Occupiers of Land within the Shire of Kulin

Formal notices have been issued recently in accordance with the Bush Fires Act 1954, to a number of properties in Kulin who are required to carry out works to clear their property of flammable material by 14 November 2018, otherwise they will receive a \$250 fine.

Burning Periods

PROHIBITED burning commenced 1 November and goes through until 15 February during which time NO BURNING is to take place within the Shire of Kulin.

OVERDUE DOG AND CAT REGISTRATIONS

The Shire of Kulin advises that licences under the Dog Act 1996 and Cat Act 2011 are overdue for renewal as of the 31 October 2018. Residents who own a cat or dog are required by law to register the animal.

If your dog or cat is currently not registered please contact the office to arrange a licence.

Bushfires and Water Supply this information could save your life



Do you live in or near a bushfire prone area?

Then now is the time to check that you are prepared in the event of a fire.



Water Corporation would also like to remind you that if you plan to stay and defend your home you must have an INDEPENDENT water supply and pumping capability. Scheme water may not be available due to damaged infrastructure, extreme demand depleting supply and pressure, or a cut to power which is used to pump water.

We have made our own preparations for the 2018/19 bushfire season by readving equipment and systems to cope with extreme conditions. Despite these efforts, it is likely there will be a reduction in water pressure, and scheme water supply tanks may run empty in the event of fire.
