

Pathways to Wave Rock Drive Trail

Kulin is the perfect base to explore the Pathways to Wave Rock Drive Trail. The trail links the towns of Quairading, Bruce Rock, Narembeen, Hyden, Lake Grace, Kulin, Kondinin and Corrigin. From massive granite outcrops to spectacular views, vibrant wildflowers and true county hospitality, this trail offers a range of unique experiences across the region.

Suggested day trip itineraries from Kulin:

1 Kulin, Corrigin, Quairading, Kwolyin, Shackleton, Bruce Rock, Ardath, Corrigin, Kulin. Approx. 320km

Trip Highlights:

West Kulin Tin Horses, Gorge Rock, Miss B's Park, Pioneer Museum & Rotary Park, Dog Cemetery, Toapin Weir, Quairading Nature Reserve, Natural Sculptures, Pink Lake, Kwolyin Camp Ground and Heritage Walk Trail, Kokerbin Rock, Smallest Bank in Australia, Shackleton Art and Sculpture Park, Bruce Rock Centennial Path, Ardath Hotel.

2 Kulin town site, Tin Horse Highway east, Jilakin Rock and Lake, Buckley's Breakaway, Pingaring, Lake Grace, Kulin. Approx. 190km

Trip Highlights:

Kulin Discovery Zone, Macrocarpa Walk Trail, Giant Waterslide (open during summer months), Tin Horse Highway, Jilakin Rock and Lake, Buckley's Breakaway, Pingaring, Walkers Hill Winery, Lake Grace Visitor Centre, Australian Inland Mission Hospital (museum), Lake Grace Art Space, Lake Grace Story Trail.

3 Kulin, Kondinin, Karlgarin, Hyden, Wave Rock, Narembeen, Kondinin, Kulin. Approx. 250km

Trip Highlights:

Kulin townsite, J.S Roe Heritage Trail, Yeerakine Rock Walk, Tressie's Museum, Wave Rock, Hidden Hollow, Narembeen Grains Discovery Centre, Roe Lookout.

4 Kulin, Tin Horse Highway east, Jilakin Lake and Rock, Buckley's Breakaway, Karlgarin, Hyden, Wave Rock, Tressie's Museum (Karlgarin), Kondinin, Kulin. Approx. 180km

Trip Highlights:

Tin Horse Highway (east), Kulin, Tin Horse Highway east, Jilakin Lake and Rock, Buckley's Breakaway, Tressie's Museum, Wave Rock, Yeerakine Rock Walk, Kondinin Lake, J.S Roe Heritage Trail.

Kulin is located on what Aboriginal people call a 'dreaming trail'. Traditional Aboriginal people travelled through this area particularly when large meetings were being held in the Eastern Wheatbelt.
