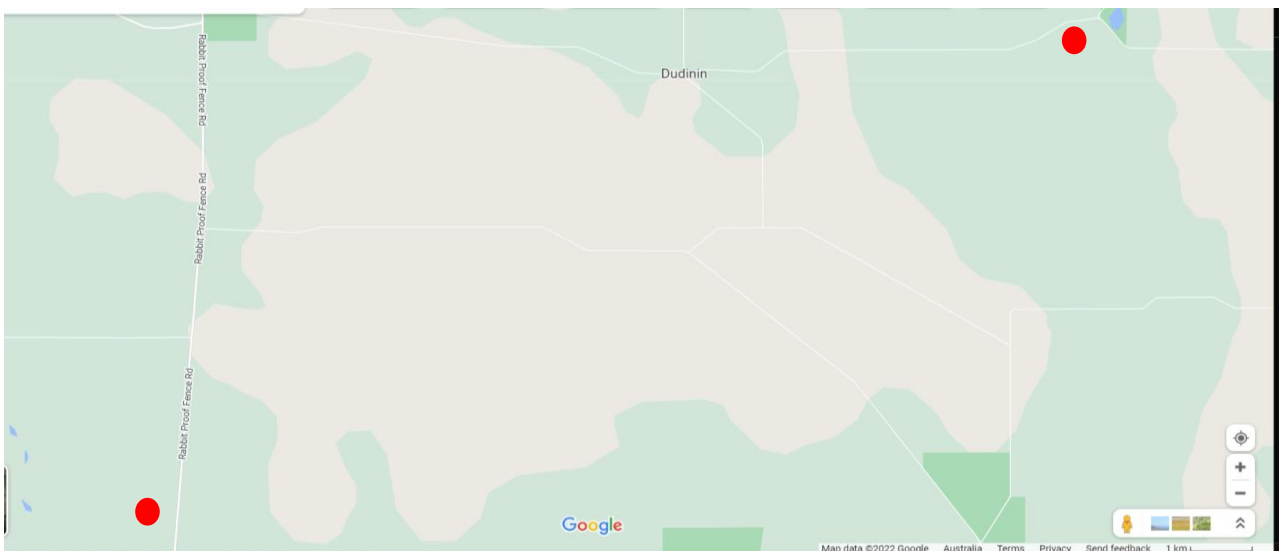

Introduction

The Shire of Kulin requires the production of 40,000m³ (approx.) of gravel in various locations within the Dudinin area. These locations can be found on the below maps. The maps are in order of preference.

PIT 1. Kirby



PIT 2. Asbury



Gravel Requirements

The Contractor will be required to undertake the following

- Strip topsoil off the ground and stockpile.
- Push up the gravel material with a bulldozer.
- Crush, screen, mix and manufacture lateritic materials to produce a basecourse quality gravel.
- 40,000m³ is required measured in stockpile after processing. The Contractor is responsible paying and arranging a surveyor to measure the stockpiles.
- The Contractor shall undertake testing weekly – 3 samples which will include Atterburg limits, psd's and soaked CBRs.
- The specification for the basecourse gravel is included below.
- Reinstate topsoil where possible.

Additional Information

- The landowners have been contacted by the Shire and the Shire will inform each landowner the movements of contractor and provide face to face meetings as the project moves forward.
- The Contractor must adhere to all landowners' requirements,
- The Contractor must cease work when a Total Fire Ban or Harvest Vehicle Movement Ban is called,

Job Safety Requirements

Prior to commencing any work, the Contractor shall demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the Client, its commitment to safety by having in place an OSH Risk Management Plan or equivalent Job Safety Analysis (JSA)/Safe Method Working Statement.

2. Opening and Registration of Tenders

All tenders lodged before closing time will be opened and registered at the closing date and time as listed. Any tenderer may be present at the opening and record the prices submitted only.

3. Acceptance of Tenders

The lowest or any tender is not necessarily accepted and canvassing of Councillors or staff will disqualify.

Council will award tenders at their Council meeting of Wednesday 27th 2022 and notice will be given by Thursday 28th July. Acceptance of tender will be affected only by written acceptance after the closing date. This tender and written acceptance thereof shall form the binding contract. A Council Work Order Form will be issued for this purpose.

4. Payment

Payment shall be made within 30 days from the end of the month of delivery of the purchased item. Cash payments will not be made. Goods and Services Tax is applicable to this tender. The tenderer must specify whether the cost per item is inclusive or exclusive of GST.

5. Annulment of Contract

Failure by the contractor to meet the agreed delivery time or any of the technical specifications will constitute grounds for the cancellation of the contract at the discretion of the Shire of Kulin.
