1 DECLARATION OF OPENING

The CEO will declare the position of President vacant and call for nominations.

The elected Shire President will be required to make and sign the Declaration of Office before Mrs Mary Lucchesi J.P

2.3 Election of Deputy President – two-year term (Schedule 2.3 – Local Government Act 1995)

Nominations for the Office of Deputy President must be in writing and presented to the Chief Executive Officer prior to 6pm Wednesday 29th October 2025.

The Chief Executive Officer will declare the position of Deputy President vacant and call for nominations.

The Elected Deputy President will be required to make and sign the Declaration of Office before Mrs Mary Lucchesi J.P
