COVID-19 VACCINE ROLLOUT

The commencement of Phase 1b of the National COVID-19 vaccine roll out has begun, from the week of 22 March 2021 in selected locations.



Many people are keen to know when, where and how to book an appointment with an approved vaccination provider within their local area.



Members of the community can check their eligibility, or that of a loved one, online via the Eligibility Checker available at <https://covid-vaccine.healthdirect.gov.au/eligibility>. If eligible, they will be able to view vaccination clinics and book an appointment online or via phone.

Further information related to local primary health care can be found on the Wheatbelt Primary Health Exchange Site at <https://phexchange.wapha.org.au/my-region-Wheatbelt> including ‘My Community Directory’ which is an online directory of health and community services.

People are asked to please be patient - the vaccination rollout will go slowly at first with more vaccination sites coming online over the next few weeks.

All eligible Australians will have the opportunity to have the vaccination in the coming months.

Contact Registers in Shire facilities

From 5 December 2020, Shire of Kulin is required to maintain mandatory contact registers for WA Health Department COVID-19 contact tracing.

Individuals can either scan the SafeWA QR Code or manually sign in at each venue.

The following venues/buildings will have contact registers:

- Kulin Aquatic Centre and Waterslide
- Freebairn Recreation Centre
- Freebairn Recreation Centre Gym
- Kulin Memorial Hall
- Kulin Public Library (located at Kulin Post Office)

The WA Government has developed a free app, SafeWA, which is a digital contact register system. The SafeWA app can be downloaded from Apple App Store or Google Play. The app is not mandatory, and an alternative paper based system is also available.

-Failing to comply to the new requirements could result in fines and penalties of up to \$50,000 for an INDIVIDUAL and \$250,000 FOR A BODY CORPORATE or 12 months imprisonment.

- Any person aged 16 years and over who attends the facility, including patrons, staff, volunteers and contractors will be required to register their contact details. Records are not required to be collected for children under 16 years.

Expressions of Interest (EOI) called from people who have a passionate interest in history, heritage, fauna and flora, agri-tourism, indigenous cultures and country who wish to join a **4WDV “Tag-Along - off the beaten track” eco-tour** travelling from Broomehill and then along the Holland Track/Way through the Wheatbelt and up the Victoria Rocks Rd (Holland Way) to the “Old Camp” and the Eastern Goldfields. We travel through the Wheatbelt towns of Katanning, Nyabing, Pingrup, Lake Grace, Newdegate and Hyden (Wave Rock) to Coolgardie, Kalgoorlie-Boulder and Norseman to celebrate and commemorate:

THE BEES KNEES – if you have a bushland patch to supply you with honey all year round add these little delights to encourage the bees to stay through the autumn-winter. They are hard to see just driving by but take a wander and you will find them hiding in the scrub. **These tend to flower with rain in summer and autumn but do mass displays in spring as well.** They grow in well drained combinations of sand, clay, loam and gravel. The seeds are hard to find and are difficult to germinate so drop by for hints on striking cuttings which flower in the first year. Closest sites are on the Macrocarpa Trail 1km NW or at the Kulin Road Nature Reserve 10km NW – park in a gravel pit and take a wander.




