Whilst Kulin Shire statistical trends across the agricultural sector follow many of the patterns of Wheatbelt towns with aging and declining populations, declining numbers per household and increasing household costs, Kulin town has had an 8.9% increase in the population even as the number of families is decreasing. The recent Sunday Times article pointing to the number of children per household being double the State average rings true — and is not yet seen in Census data.

Of all the statistical information available from the Census, one that stands out for me and absolutely demonstrates why Kulin Shire is leading this State of WA in "community development" is this;

#### UNPAID WORK

Voluntary Work through an organisation or a group 44.1%

And what would you think is the **National Average for voluntary work - 19%.** My research for WA finds that many of our near neighbours and like communities sit with volunteer levels at 25-30%, so the message is clear. **Volunteering and personal contribution MAKES community.** Be proud, it is a worthy thing that you have achieved. In this department – Kulin may well be leading the Nation.

# Kulin's Baby Boom





KULIN is fertile in more ways than one, with ideal growing conditions for wheat, sheep — and basses.

New Australian Bureau of Statistics data reveals the women in the small Wheothelt town — best known for its Tin Horse Highway — are among WA's most fertile.

Kolin's fertility rate was 3.12 habies born to such woman over the course of her lifetime.

It's part of a baby boom in country WA, with the top 10 most fertile locations dotted across our visit State. In 2016, more than

In 2015, more than 35,000 habies were born in WA, including 72 in Kulin, 280km east of Perth

Another Wheathelt town, Brookton, has WA's highest fertility rate at 3.3.

WA's average fertility rate is 1,89. The least fertile areas were Perth CBD (0.9) and North Coopee (1.1)

Kulin Shire president and local farmer Barry West, who raised four kids with wife Peta, said the town owed its mini population boom to a strong community spirit.

"Kulin is very accepting of new people and exergone volunteers to help out for different things like our book race." Mr West said.

"We've got a lot of young professionals who have moved here in recent years and built homes here.

"We've gut some great facilities here for young families inchedrag a strong playgroup for young purents, day care and good medical services."

Gen Whisson moved to

Kulin eight years ago with husband Ben and the couple are parents to 19-month-old son Huxley.

The 33-year-old works as a private farming consultant and is about to open a florist business.

She said her previous job as a senior project officer for Kailo Shire to help promote local trumsm attractions had given her plenty of scope to broaden her skills.

"I think a lot of people tend to misjudge small country towns but there's always so much going on,"

She said getting involved in volunteering was a "big part of country life".

Cindy Muslan, 33, who lives on a pig and wheat farm with three kids and basband Brenton, said the town was family oriented and had great facilities for families.

"Everyone makes an effort to include you in sporting games and kale' groups and there's a great childcare centre." she said.

# Protecting Your Pets During An Emergency

More than 60 per cent of Australian households include a much loved pet and with the bush fire season upon us it's important our furry friends are included in the family bush fire survival plan.

Department of Fire and Emergency Service (DFES) Director of Community Preparedness Suellen Flint said actions for keeping pets safe were often left out when putting together an evacuation plan.

"Given we hold animals so close to our hearts, it is only natural that bushfire survival plans should include what you will do with your animals if you need to evacuate," Suellen said.

There are several things you can do to prepare for a possible evacuation if you have pets.

- 1. Make sure your pet is properly micro-chipped and collared
- **2.** Have a bag near the front door containing a lead, some food, a water bowl and any medications they may need
- **3**. If you can't take your animals with you make sure they are not tied up so they can escape if necessary.

"While evacuation centres provide temporary accommodation during emergencies, they often do not accommodate animals other than trained assistance dogs," Suellen said.

"If you are evacuating during a bushfire, you should try to take your pets with you on the first trip. You may have the best intentions of going back to get your pets on a second trip, only to find when you return that the roads have been closed because the area is unsafe."



DFES and RSPCA WA recommend community members talk to their local government regarding where their pets can stay during an emergency, or ask family and friends if they can temporarily care for pets until the evacuation is over.

DFES and RSPCA have developed this video which outlines the steps to consider when evacuating with your pets (see link below).

#### Kulin Bush Races 2017/2018 Funding Guidelines

#### 1. Grants are made to:

- a) Community organisations or groups based in the Shire of Kulin, operating on a not for profit basis where the purpose of the grant benefits the community.
- b) Local Government Authorities where the purpose of the grant benefits the community.

#### 2. Conditions of application:

- a) Application is to be in writing using the Grant Application Form and submitted by 19<sup>th</sup> March 2018.
- b) Quotes outlining funding requirements are to be attached to the application.
- c) Supporting minutes are to be attached to the application.
- d) A current audited Financial Report is to be attached to the application.
- e) A budget of the proposed project is to be attached to the application.

#### 3. Conditions of grant:

- a) The grant must be used for the purpose for which it is given.
- b) The grant must be used within 6 months (by 30th September 2018) unless otherwise stated by Kulin Bush Races (KBR). KBR must be advised if any delays occur relating to the expenditure of the grant and a written request must be made seeking approval for extension of time.
- c) The grant is to be expended by submitting original invoices for payment to the KBR committee. Organisations will not receive grant money directly unless otherwise stated by KBR.
- d) Unexpended funds will be retained by KBR for future funding allocations.
- e) Where appropriate the grant is to be publicly acknowledged by the successful organisation and signage/plaques recognising the contribution will be erected at a cost to the KBR.
- f) Local businesses must be supported in all grant applications wherever possible.
- g) Applicants must show that their organisation is contributing to the project either by in-kind labour, materials and/or funding.
- h) Projects must have the potential to benefit the wider community.
- All organisations applying for funding must have an ABN.

#### 4. Grants are not made for:

- a) Ongoing costs (salaries, administration).
- b) General fundraising appeal or fundraising on behalf of another organisation.
- c) Repayment of loans.
- d) Interstate or overseas travel and tours, camps or conferences.
- e) Payment of goods already purchased.
- f) Activities that do not occur in Kulin or are not of direct benefit to the Kulin community.
- g) Applications which request funds for retrospective payments and for deficits.
- h) Direct sponsorship of another event.

#### Grants are not made to:

- a) Private or for-profit organisations.
- b) Individuals.
- c) Sponsorships where the main focus is on fundraising.

Funding will be allocated at the discretion of the Kulin Bush Races Committee. The decision of the Kulin Bush Races Committee is final
