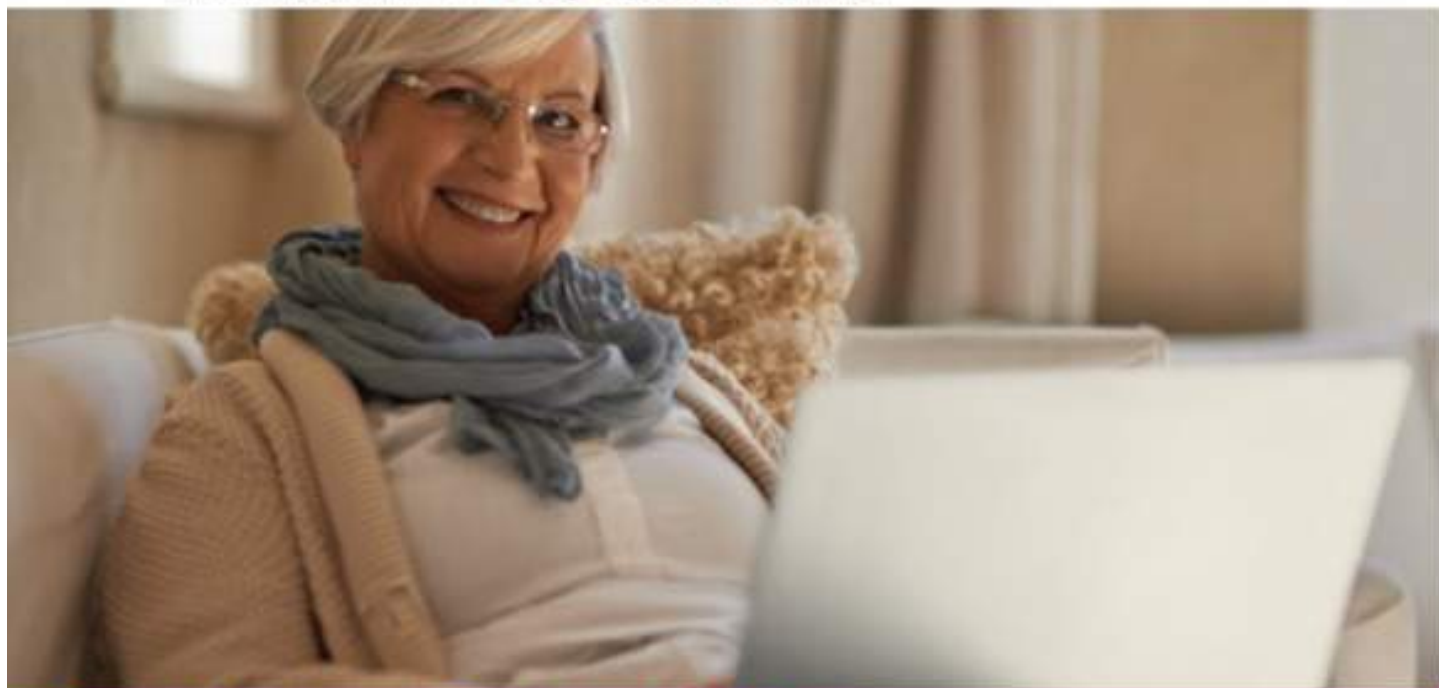

End of year notes 2018

Almost Christmas again. The Harvest Place continues to thrive. We are blessed with a steady supply of saleable items from Kondinin, Kulin and kindly people from other places. There has been an increase of donations this year which keeps Betty, 'our unpacking and sorting specialist' constantly busy. We thank her as a vital member of the team. Thanks to the Uniting Church for allowing us to use the church for storage space. Our appreciation also goes to the Shire of Kondinin, and the Kulin Tyre Service for providing a collection point in the yellow wheelie bins. There are still two large bins at the back of the shop for goods as well. As these bins are not always waterproof, goods need to be in plastic bags for protection. During the year new clothes racks were purchased to enable convenience and better presentation of clothes. This has made the display more attractive and the tasks easier for the volunteers. Change of season displays involve much sorting and rearranging. Excess goods are donated on to places similar to our shop. Many thanks to Al and Teresa Whyte who went out of their way to deliver a load to Perth. Many travellers passing through call in and have a cuppa or purchase books or extra t-shirts or warm jackets and tops if the weather turns chilly.

At the recent AGM funds were distributed for the year.

Kondinin and Kulin Schools each received \$50 for end of year book prizes.

Royal Flying Doctor Service was sent \$1000.

Camp Kulin received \$1500 to sponsor four children to summer camp.

Kulin District High School received \$2000 to support the Team Building Camp in early 2019. We supported this as Kondinin students attend KDHS.

Kondinin Primary School received \$500 to assist with the Music Program next year.

Other local needs can be considered by the committee.

Toys and books are either given away or we accept a small donation. King Edward memorial Hospital has been donated baby clothes in small sizes, clothes for small children, and sleepwear and dressing gowns for adult patients who often come in via the Emergency Dept. without having time to pack a bag. Baby clothes and blankets were sent to "Little things for Tiny Tots" a group that helps mothers in need. We donated a suitcase of material to Joseph's Coat, which is a Christian group in Perth who sew new garments for overseas children in need. Many thanks to our dedicated Committee and Volunteers who put in countless hours and days to provide this service to the community.

The shop will be closed for two weeks over Christmas and open in January mornings only.

A big THANK YOU to all of our customers and providers of goods who have made it possible for us to continue and prosper.

We wish you all a safe and blessed Christmas and summer holiday season. May this Holy season grant you happiness and Peace in the name of Christ.

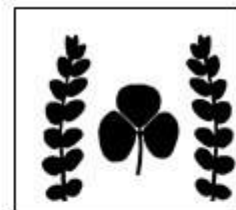
