

Save our CWA

Thank you to all community members who attended the public meeting held Wednesday 24th October 2018 to discuss the future of the Kulin CWA premises. It was agreed that the building has served the Kulin community well for 81 years as a small, well appointed, well positioned meeting place for a wide range of activities supporting a wide range of community groups. Currently up to 12 bookings occur each month – i.e. the building is still a well utilised one and worthy of retaining.

Over the years numerous discussions have been held with the State CWA and the Kulin Shire in regards to ownership of the Kulin CWA. Given the conditional freehold title of the land is held by the State WA CWA and transfer of the conditional title to the Kulin Shire or surrender of the land back to the State appear likely to be costly and lengthy processes, the meeting agreed to put the ownership discussion to one side and go ahead and address maintenance issues to secure the building and ensure people can gather safely and comfortably at the Kulin CWA for the near future.

Stage 1. To prevent further degradation of the building it was agreed that the problem of poor drainage should be addressed. Runoff is currently heading under the building and ponding around the footings and front garden area. Redirecting water into the street drainage on Johnston Street will likely involve continuing downpipes into underground drainage pipes that head towards the front fence and underneath the public pavement in order to drain into the street gutters. The Kulin Shire will be approached to assist with the drainage work, in particular where the public pavement and street drainage is concerned. Costs to complete Stage 1 should be moderate – with community volunteers likely to be able to assist with the drainage work.

Stage 2. A building maintenance report to be sought and quotes requested for works to be carried out. Costs of Stage 2 are likely to be more substantial. Assistance will be sought from various grants that might be accessible for such a project.

The Kulin CWA will keep the community informed of progress.



Formal notices have been issued recently in accordance with the Bush Fires Act 1954, to a number of properties in Kulin who are required to carry out works to clear their property of flammable material by 14 November 2018, otherwise they will receive a \$250 fine.
