

CEO CORNER

Welcome back to another CEO corner for 2021, as we move into spring, some warmer day time weather and a couple of frost scares seem to be the order of the past week.

The Local Government Election process is in full swing, with nominations for Council open from Thursday 2nd September to 4pm Thursday 9th September. More information is available on Page 5.

Last week we held the Annual Kulin Bushfire Brigade AGM. Thank you to Pingaring Golf Club for hosting this event. Congratulations to Rod Diery on being appointed as Chief Fire Control Officer with Evan Wyatt being appointed Deputy CFO. Training as is looking to be organised with DFES on Tuesday 19th October to bring various brigade members up to speed on the operation of the trucks as well as a "Farmer Response Course" which is a tailored course to meet the requirements of farmers as opposed to the Introduction

to Bush Fire Fighting which is quite an extensive course. We are also looking at undertaken FCO Training for potentially new FCOs.

The All Ages Precinct continues to take shape. The skate zone component has been completed and the pump track and hangout areas are well underway. Staff have also submitted a funding application to Lotterywest to further assist with Stage 2 Ninja Warrior Course.

At the Aquatic Centre the pool repair works are finally completed as of today. We've also commenced works to replace the concrete platforms on the slide structure. This will be undertaken over the next couple of weeks. The additional shade structure with solar panels on the western grass area has been delayed until after the Pool Season to meet funding requirements.

We are still awaiting on confirmation regarding FRC Court resurfacing. The contractor is Queensland based and are having challenges entering WA due to COVID border restrictions. It is looking more likely that this will be delayed until January to March 2022.

Good luck to KDHS students in the Annual Interschool Athletics Carnival next Tuesday, to be held in Narembeen.

On a staff note I'd like to congratulate thank and Rod "Rocket" Diery on his retirement following 20 years of service with the Shire. This is certainly an extended period to work with any organisation. No doubt he will still be around the place with his active involvement with the VBFB and the Fire and Rescue teams. He might even come back for some recreational grading driving from time to time. Enjoy your retirement Rocket.

As always plenty happening in Kulin, until next time safe travels.

Nominations are called for the Shire of Kulin Local Government Elections, to be held on **Saturday 16 October 2021** to fill vacancies on the Council.

What is involved?

As a Councillor you would be involved in running an organisation with the responsibility of making decisions that have a major impact on our lifestyle. As a representative of your community you will find the role enjoyable, challenging and stimulating with involvement in matters as diverse as recreation, libraries, the environment, town planning, health, roads and many more. Meeting fees and some expenses are paid.

Who can nominate?

Any person who is an Australian Citizen over the age of 18 years who is an elector of the district and is not disqualified under the *Local Government Act 1995* may nominate for council. It is not a requirement that a candidate lives or owns property in the ward for which they nominate (if wards used).

Nomination Time and Place

- Nominations for all vacancies open on Thursday, 2 September 2021
- Nominations must be lodged by 4.00pm, Thursday, 9 September 2021
- Nominations must be lodged at any time during the above period at the Shire of Kulin Administration Office.

Nomination Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the RETURNING OFFICER:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Shire Office or via the website <u>www.kulin.wa.gov.au</u>
- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs. The profile may include a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, or postal order, or bank cheque) subject to Returning Officer approval.
- A recent passport size photograph (optional).
- Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or emailed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

Full details about eligibility and nomination procedures for prospective candidates in this election can be obtained by contacting the Kulin Shire Office.



Government must act to ramp up vaccination rates for Wheatbelt, says Davies

Local Member for Central Wheatbelt Mia Davies MLA has called on the Labor Government to ramp up efforts to increase vaccination rates in Wheatbelt communities.

She said vaccination rates needed to rapidly improve, calling for alternative delivery methods to be considered to ensure people living in all corners of the State could get the jab.

"The fact that only 19.4 percent of eligible people are fully vaccinated in Merredin and 25 percent in Northam is simply not good enough," Ms Davies said.

"Low vaccine rates and a struggling health system are a recipe for disaster.

"The Government should consider implementing measures like targeted pop-up clinics in rural and remote areas to quickly boost accessibility and uptake of the vaccine."

Ms Davies said the Opposition had made suggestions to set up walk-in clinics at major regional events, but the Labor Government had rejected the idea.

"We know a majority of West Australians want to roll up their sleeves and get the job done, but that is difficult to do when we have regional clinics that are only open a few times a week," she said.

"It needs to be made as simple as possible for everyone, and the figures released over the weekend demonstrate there's more work to be done.

"The Health Minister says that targeted walk-in clinics may eventually be part of the solution and I'm asking why it isn't part of the solution already."

"Vaccination and investment in our crumbling health system are key to WA avoiding what's happening in NSW, and we should be making every effort to do this while we are COVID-free," Ms Davies said.

"Labor must be more creative when it comes to vaccine accessibility, otherwise we will continue to see these low rates in communities."






