We welcome Caroline to the team and have no doubt her extensive skills and enthusiasm will be an asset to the centre and Shire.







Kulin Arts and the Kulin Community Arts Centre Events





CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries must be for sale. All sales are subject to 10% commission.
- Artists can enter four (4) artworks only, which must be the original work of the artist and not previously exhibited at Newdegate.
- The committee reserves the right to reject or reclassify any artwork. All entries exhibited will be judged. The judge, at their discretion may decide not to present an award. The judge's decision is final.
- All art work must be ready for display with a secure hanging assembly or be safe free standing 3D works.
- Maximum size limit for 3D work is 1600mm height. Maximum size limit for 2D work is 1300x1300mm (including frame) and maximum weight is 12kg.
- The organisers reserve the right to reproduce entries in print, film or digital format for promotion and documentation purposes.
- Each artwork must have a completed artwork label attached on the back bottom left hand side or suitable place on 3D artworks.
- Signed entry forms must be sent with entry fee. Entry form and money must not be enclosed with artwork.
- A \$10 per artist (NOT per entry) fee will be charged for use of depots, payable with the entry fee.
- All works left at the depots for transfer to Newdegate must be suitably packaged for transport or they will not be accepted.
